Paper-Based Patient Entry

- Patient brings in an opioid Rx. Have them fill out the [Patient Intake Form](#)
- Once completed, give the form to the pharmacist
- Process Rx as usual
- Score Patient Intake Form using [Opioid Risk Tool \(ORT\)](#)
- [Triage](#) the patient and provide interventions as necessary such as naloxone dispensing/counseling, medication take back programs and/or opioid partial fills
- Give [ND DHS brochure](#) to all patients who receive opioid prescription
- Give [ONE Program brochure](#) to patients who are counseled on naloxone
- Fill out [Outcomes Worksheet](#) after talking to patient
- Input Patient Intake Form into [DocStation](#)
- Input Outcomes Worksheet into [DocStation](#)
